

Bug Police Flea Control Procedure

PREPARATION:

In order for a flea control program to work we need your help. Sanitation is a very important part of our control program. By completing the items listed below you will enable Bug police to provide the most effective flea control procedure available, performed with EPA registered and approved materials. This procedure works best when both inside and outside areas and pets are treated at the same time.

CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY CHECKLIST:

All items removed from floors (including closets, under the beds, etc.) o All NON carpet floor areas swept and mopped. If carpets are to be cleaned this is done prior to treatment.

- All carpet and furniture vacuumed and bags disposed of outside the home. e Miscellaneous pet contact areas cleaned and vacuumed. (example: cat's window seals, furniture, shelves and any animal bedding).
- Pet bedding cleaned or removed.
- All pets removed, salt water tanks are removed before treatment, fresh water tanks only cover and shut pump off. Pets treated and shampooed by vet or owner. .l
- Pet food and or litter box cleaned and removed.
- Turn off A/C before treatment begins.
- I understand that vacuuming each day for 5 days following treatment will increase the effectiveness of the flea control program.
- The products used for treatment have been formulated not to leave an offensive odor, However, should a slight odor be present upon arrival after treatment you may need to open a window to help ventilate the area for usually an hour.
- Do not reenter for 2 hours.
- Do not allow anyone or any pets on carpets until completely dry. o All outside grass should be mowed, clippings removed and leaf cover removed. o People and pets should remain off treated lawn for 2 hours or until the treatment has thoroughly dried.
- Removed all pet dishes and toys from the area to be treated. I fully understand and have been explained the importance of staying off and out of the treated areas for the minimum times mentioned and until the products have dried. This is a minimum of 2 hours.
